SCHEDULING ORDER

18 Pursuant to the parties' stipulation, (*Morales I*, Doc. No. 552; *Pac. News Serv.*, Doc. No.
19 128), the Court hereby vacates the current stipulated schedule, (*Morales I*, Doc. No. 531;
20 *Morales II*, Doc. No. 74; *Pac. News Serv.*, Doc. No. 124), and adopts the parties' proposed
21 schedule, (*Morales I*, Doc. No. 552 at 2; *Pac. News Serv.*, Doc. No. 128 at 2). The parties shall
22 submit a new proposed schedule within thirty days after (1) viable lethal-injection regulations
23 are in place or (2) the Marin Superior Court's decision invalidating the regulations, *Sims v. Cal.*
24 *Dep't of Corr. & Rehab.*, No. CIV 1004019 (Cal. Super. Ct. Marin Cnty. Feb. 21, 2012), is
25 overturned on appellate review, whichever occurs first.

It is so ordered.
