**MEMORANDUM\*\***

\*1 This appeal from the district court's order granting  
appellees' motion for preliminary injunction comes to us  
for review under Ninth Circuit Rule 3-3. We have  
jurisdiction under 28 U.S.C. § 1292(a)(1), and we affirm.

Our sole inquiry is whether the district court abused its  
discretion in granting preliminary injunctive relief. *See*  
*Gregorio T. v. Wilson*, 59 F.3d 1002, 1004-05 (9th  
Cir.1995). The record before us shows that the court did  
not rely on an erroneous legal premise or abuse its  
discretion in concluding that appellees had demonstrated  
the existence of serious legal questions and that the  
balance of hardships tipped in favor of appellees and in  
granting preliminary injunctive relief. *See id.* The court's  
factual findings and application of legal standards are not  
clearly erroneous. *See id.* Accordingly, the court's order  
granting the preliminary injunction is affirmed.
