**[PROPOSED] ORDER**

Pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 23, it is hereby ORDERED that a class is certified consisting of all individuals who (a) have or had a physical or mental impairment that substantially limits one or more major life activities within the meaning of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, as amended, 42 U.S.C. § 12101, *et seq.*, or have a record of such an impairment; (b) are or were eligible to apply for benefits from a New York City Human Resources Administration (“HRA”) Disaster Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (“D-SNAP”), including the D-SNAP benefits offered in response to “Superstorm Sandy”; (c) reside

or resided in the covered zip codes for an HRA D-SNAP program; and (d) need or needed reasonable accommodations to enable them to apply for D-SNAP benefits.
