
ORDERED, that Section 1 of the Transition Order of May 5, 2010 is hereby further amended to provide that the transition period shall be extended until October 31, 2011;

ORDERED, that in the period leading up to the transition date, the Supervising Court Master shall make such announced and unannounced reviews of the management and operations of the Division of Transportation as he deems appropriate; and

ORDERED, that after the start of the 2011-12 School Year, the Supervising Court Master shall conduct a comprehensive analysis of the management and operations of the Division of Transportation and shall submit to the Court and the parties no later than October 11, 2011, a Report and Recommendation that sets forth his analysis of the

extent to which the Division is in compliance with the Orders of this Court and his recommendations as to what further actions should be taken and what further orders entered.
