**ORDER OF DISMISSAL AND GRANTING LEAVE TO
EARNESTINE OWENS AND ANGELA B. TAYLOR TO FILE
SEPARATE COMPLAINTS**

Based on the November 24, 1997, Consent Decree entered herein, the exclusion from the settlement of the claims of co-plaintiff Earnestine Owens and intervenor Angela B. Taylor, and the September 24, 1999, Order of the Court, this action is hereby DISMISSED, with prejudice to the claims of all of the class members other than Earnestine Owens and Angela B. Taylor.

The individual claims of Earnestine Owens and Angela B. Taylor heretofore asserted in this case may proceed via separate complaints to be filed by them within ninety (90) days of the date of this Order of Dismissal. The filing fees for the separate complaint shall be waived; and for purposes of the statutes of limitations, each separate complaint shall be deemed to have been filed as of August 24, 1992. The separate complaints shall be

randomly assigned to a judge of the court.

Should the said Owens and Taylor fail to file a separate complaint within the ninety-day period, their individual claims shall be deemed to have been dismissed with prejudice as of the ninety-first day following entry of this Order of Dismissal.

Each party shall bear its own costs.

The Clerk of the Court is hereby instructed to close this case.
