ORDER

The above-captioned matter came for trial by jury before the undersigned District Judge from March 21, 2011 to March 24, 2011. Pursuant to the jury verdict returned March 24, 2011,

IT IS ORDERED that judgment will be rendered **in favor of Plaintiff**, Equal Employment Opportunity Commission and **against Defendant** Boh Brothers Construction Company, LLC in the amount of TWO HUNDRED ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$201,000.00) in compensatory damages consisting on ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,000.00) for back pay and benefits and TWO HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$200,000.00) for emotional pain and suffering, inconvenience, mental anguish, and loss of enjoyment of life.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that judgment will be further rendered **in favor of Plaintiff**, Equal Employment Opportunity Commission and **against Defendant** Boh Brothers Construction Company , LLC in the amount of TWO HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$250,000.00) in punitive damages.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Plaintiff shall file a motion for injunctive relief as requested in the complaint as well as any

remaining issues regarding damages, along with necessary supporting documentation **NO LATER THAN APRIL 8, 2011**; responsive memorandum in opposition to that motion shall be due from defendant **NO LATER THAN 10 DAYS FROM RECEIPT OF PLAINTIFF'S MOTION** ; thereafter plaintiff may file a reply, **NO LATER THAN 5 DAYS AFTER** receipt of defendant's reply to plaintiff's submissions. Hearing on the motion for injunctive relief shall occur on **APRIL 27, 2011 AT 9:00 A.M.** in open court. The Court hereby directs the Clerk of Court to conduct a taxation of costs hearing to assess costs in favor of the prevailing plaintiff.
