ORDER ADMINISTRATIVELY TERMINATING PENDING MOTIONS

Pending before the Court are Plaintiffs' motion for summary judgment (doc. 71) and Defendants' motion to dismiss or, in the alternative, for summary judgment (doc. 75). One of the Plaintiffs, the University of Dallas, also sought a preliminary injunction, which this Court granted (doc. 99). Defendants have sought an interlocutory appeal of that order from the Fifth Circuit (doc. 101).

Because the Fifth Circuit has yet to resolve (or even grant) the interlocutory appeal, and in an effort to efficiently manage this Court's docket, the Court concludes that the best course of action is to ADMINISTRATIVELY TERMINATE the pending motions in this case (docs. 71 & 75). Following the resolution of the interlocutory appeal by the Fifth Circuit, the above motions will be automatically reinstated on this Court's docket and ruled upon in due course.
