JOINT STATUS REPORT

Pursuant to the Court’s Minute Order dated February 15, 2019, Plaintiff American-Arab Anti-Discrimination Committee and Defendant U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) submit the following joint status report.

1. The parties have resolved their differences as to CBP’s search for and production of non-exempt, responsive records subject to the FOIA. The only remaining issue for the parties to discuss is possible attorneys’ fees under the FOIA.

2. Counsel for Plaintiff intends to provide counsel for Defendant a proposed fee petition no later than March 6, 2019. Over the next few weeks, counsel for Defendant will review the proposed fee petition and the parties will discuss next steps.

3. Accordingly, the parties propose filing another joint status report by March 22, 2019 to update the Court on the parties’ anticipated course of action with respect to attorneys’ fees.
