After that motion was fully briefed, the First Circuit granted Defendants' interlocutory appeal of the preliminary injunction entered in this matter. <u>USCA Opinion 97</u>. In doing so, the First Circuit addressed some of the issues raised in the <u>Motion to Dismiss</u>. In light of that Opinion, the requested continuance, and the potential changes to "the contours of the issues in this case," updated briefing would be helpful to the court if the action proceeds.
