**ORDER**

On April 23, 2020, the Court granted Petitioners' application for a preliminary injunction and directed the parties to propose reasonable conditions of release for Petitioners. ECF No. 32. Having reviewed the parties' proposed conditions, ECF No. 37, it is ORDERED that the following conditions of release shall apply to Isidro Picazo Nicolas:

1. Petitioner shall reside only at the address provided to the Court in the parties' joint filing on April 27, 2020;
2. Petitioner shall comply with all national, state, local, and Centers for Disease Control and Prevention guidelines and orders regarding COVID-19;
3. Petitioner shall be subject to telephonic monitoring by Immigrations and Customs Enforcement ("ICE");
4. Petitioner shall provide ICE with a working telephone number at which he may be reached;
5. Petitioner shall not commit a federal, state, or local crime;
6. Petitioner shall abide by the terms of the order of protection issued against him by a New York state court; and

7. Petitioner shall appear for any court hearings at which his presence is required, including proceedings before an immigration judge.
