1 On October 25, 2016 at 10:00 a.m., the Court took under submission the Parties' Joint
2 Motion for Class Certification under Rules 23(a), 23(b)(1), and 23(b)(2) of the Federal Rules of
3 Civil Procedure. Having reviewed the submitted papers, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED,
4 ADJUDGED and DECREED as follows:

5 1. The numerosity, commonality, typicality, and adequacy requirements of Rule 23(a)
6 are satisfied.

7 2. The requirements under both Rule 23(b)(1) and Rule 23(b)(2) are satisfied.

8 3. The Action is hereby certified as a class action as to all claims and defenses at issue
9 in the Complaint pursuant to Rules 23(a), 23(b)(1), and 23(b)(2) of the Federal Rules of Civil
10 Procedure.

11 4. The Class is defined as:

12 All people who are now, or in the future will be, incarcerated in the Santa
13 Clara County jails.

14 5. This class action also includes a Subclass, which is defined as:

15 All people who are now, or in the future will be, incarcerated in the Santa Clara
16 County jails and who have a psychiatric and/or intellectual disability, as defined
17 under the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), 42 U.S.C. §12101 et seq., and
Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act, 29 U.S.C. § 794.

18 6. Plaintiffs Chavez and Bracamonte will serve as representatives of the Class, and
19 Plaintiff Bracamonte will serve as a representative of the Subclass.

20 7. Pursuant to Rule 23(c)(2)(A), the parties shall submit a proposed notice to the class
21 and the method of distribution of that notice within 14 days of this Order.

22 8. Cooley LLP, the Prison Law Office, and Kendall Dawson Wasley are appointed as
23 class counsel to represent the interests of the plaintiff class.
