MOTION FOR APPROVAL OF SETTLEMENT OF CLASS ACTION

Litt as Class Counsel for the Class;
 - c. schedules a hearing on the fairness of this Settlement, pursuant to Rule23 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, and for final approval of thisSettlement;
 - d. directs that notice of this Settlement be given to the Class; and

- e. otherwise authorizes the parties to engage in the activity provided for in the Settlement Agreement designed to advance the settlement process.
