ORDER

Let a Writ of Habeas Corpus Ad Testificandum be issued to the Wardens of the Madison Parish Correctional Center in Tallulah, Louisiana and Elayn Hunt Correctional Center in St. Gabriel, Louisiana or one of their authorized Assistant Wardens. DONALD WASHINGTON is to be transported to the Elayn Hunt Correctional Center in St. Gabriel, Louisiana from his current place of incarceration. DONALD WASHINGTON must be transported from the Elayn Hunt Correctional Center to United States District Court for the Eastern District of Louisiana on each day of the scheduled trial. At the end of each trial date, DONALD WASHINGTON will be transported back to the Elayn Hunt Correctional Center. Upon arrival at United States District Court for the Eastern District of Louisiana, the United States Marshal for the Eastern District of Louisiana, or her lawful deputy, or any other United States Marshal, will assist in transporting DONALD WASHINGTON to Court. Upon completion of his testimony, DONALD WASHINGTON will be returned to the Wardens' custody.
