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
STIPULATED ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Consistent with the terms of the settlement agreement entered into by Plaintiffs Elizabeth Seitz, Mersiha Tuzlic, Riva DePasse, Jill Hendricks, and Kiari Day and Defendants Allegheny County, Orlando Harper, Simon Wainwright, Monica Long, and Jesse Andrascik (“Parties”), the Parties stipulate and agree, pursuant to Rule 41(1)(1)(A)(ii) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, to dismissal of Defendant Allegheny County with prejudice, on the condition that the Court retain jurisdiction to enforce the terms of their settlement agreement under the authority of *Kokkonen v. Guardian Life Insurance Co. of America*, 511 U.S. 375, 381-82 (1994). The terms of the settlement agreement entered into on November 2, 2017, which is provided to the Court as Exhibit A, are incorporated by reference. Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. By consent of the parties, the Court shall retain jurisdiction for the purpose of

enforcing the terms of the Settlement Agreement through November 2, 2020.

2. Except as provided for in paragraph 1 above, the claims are DISMISSED with prejudice and without costs.
