**ORDER**

AND NOW, this 7<sup>th</sup> day of August 2019, upon considering the Class Plaintiffs’ Motion for a preliminary injunction on behalf of the Class (ECF Doc. No. 189), Defendants’ Response (ECF Doc. No. 210), finding we previously granted preliminary injunctive relief (ECF Doc. No. 135) requiring Defendants propose a plan for implementing injunctive relief now stayed pending the United States Court of Appeals’ review of our July 15, 2019 Order (ECF Doc. No. 196), and further finding, after three evidentiary hearings, the same likelihood of success and irreparable harm exist for female Trusty inmates certified as part of the Class as previously awarded to Plaintiff Alice Velazquez-Diaz under our May 20, 2019 Order (ECF Doc. No. 135), it is

**ORDERED:**

1. Subject to the posting of a \$100 bond on behalf of the Class Members with the Clerk of Court, Class Plaintiffs’ Motion for preliminary injunction (ECF Doc. No. 189) is **GRANTED** to compel Defendants to implement their proposed plan under our July 15, 2019 Order (ECF Doc. No. 196) for all Class Members; but,
2. Consistent with our Court of Appeals’ July 19, 2019 Order<sup>1</sup> staying our July 15, 2019 Order (ECF Doc. No. 196), we **stay** implementation of this Order until further Order.
