ORDER

This matter is before the Court on the Motion of Defendants for Hearing on Plaintiff’s Preliminary Injunction Motion [Doc. 38]. In this motion, defendants move the Court for a hearing on plaintiff’s motion for a preliminary injunction [Doc. 2]. The Court notes that in its order staying this case [Doc. 34], the Court denied all pending motions—including plaintiff’s preliminary injunction motion—with leave to refile upon the lifting of the stay. The stay in this case has since been lifted, and plaintiff has not refiled its motion for a preliminary injunction. Accordingly, the Court **DENIES** defendants’ motion [Doc. 38] as **MOOT**.
