SECOND REPORT OF TA ON TRANSITION ISSUES

Earl Dunlap, Transitional Administrator (TA) of the Cook County Juvenile Temporary Detention Center (JTDC), hereby submits the following second status report on transition issues.

- 1. In advance of the March 17, 2015 status hearing, the TA would like to briefly apprise the Court of transition-related developments.
- 2. Mr. Dixon has continued to become familiar with JTDC operations and ready himself for the TA's departure.
- 3. The TA has prepared a transition timeline to function as a sort of "to-do" list to guide the *Doe* parties and Mr. Dixon through the transition process. A copy of this list is attached here as Exhibit A.
- 4. On March 10, 2015, the *Doe* parties, the TA, and Mr. Dixon to met to discuss the items on the TA's transition timeline.

- 5. The parties agreed that it was too early to set completion dates for the various tasks, as several of them require additional coordination with OCJ and agencies involved in implementation of capital projects.
- 6. The TA is believes that the parties will be able to negotiate dates of completion for these tasks after the March 17, 2015 status hearing.

Conclusion

The TA hopes that this brief report will be useful to the Court at the upcoming status hearing.
