FINAL JUDGMENT PURSUANT TO RULE 54(b)

In accordance with the Court’s [Amended] Order, Docket No. 170 entered on June 11, 2015, the Court hereby enters a Final Judgment in favor of the Plaintiffs on the Defendants’ Motion to Terminate Prospective Relief, Docket No. 129. Because the Court denied the Defendants’ Motion to Consolidate and held a hearing only on the completely severed issues, *see* Docket No. 170, at n.2, the Court finds that there is no just reason for delay for entry of final judgment on the claims considered at the evidentiary hearing held on April 1, 2, 3, 23, 24 and 27, of 2015. All reasons for extending the consent decree on these issues are set forth in the Court’s [Amended] Order. The other issues related to medical care remain between the parties and are still open.

Accordingly, a Final Judgment pursuant to Fed.R.Civ.P. 54(b) is appropriate and is hereby entered.
