- Jury Verdict. This action came before the Court for a trial by jury. The issues have been tried and the jury rendered its verdict.
- Decision by Court. This action came to hearing before the Court. The issues have been heard and a decision has been rendered.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that a permanent injunction is issued. Defendant shall, effective immediately, restore the level of approved skilled nursing services to be provided to Plaintiff David Grooms under the Persons with Disabilities (“PWD”) Waiver in the amount approved by HFS prior to his 21st birthday, i.e., not less than 112 hours per week, plus 336 hours of respite care per year, at rates sufficient to assure consistent competent skilled nursing services for the approved hours. Plaintiff is awarded his reasonable attorneys’ fees, costs and litigation expenses, to be determined at a later date pursuant to Local Rules 54.1 and 54.3. The court shall retain jurisdiction of this matter for purposes of enforcement of this Order.
