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| | | <p>this case filed their original complaint 1 on April 24, 2020. A few days later, Plaintiffs filed an amended complaint 11. Shortly before midnight last night, Plaintiffs filed three motions: (1) a motion for temporary restraining order 13, (2) a motion to expedite 14, and (3) a motion for leave to file excess pages 15. The motion for leave to file excess pages 15 is granted and Plaintiffs' 35-page brief is accepted instanter. The motion to expedite 14 is also granted. The motion for TRO 13 is taken under advisement. Based on the Court's initial review of the motions and supporting memorandum, it is clear that expedited briefing should be ordered. However, as Plaintiffs point out [see 15, at 2], their case involves high level of "complexity" and requires the presentation of a "vast amount of information and arguments" in oversized briefing, all of which requires adequate time and space to present cogently for the Court's consideration. In other words, while the motion will receive expedited treatment, the briefing schedule should not be so compressed as to compromise quality of the parties' presentations, particularly since the CARES Act was signed into law on March 27 [see 13, at 4] and the TRO motion was not brought until April 30. To facilitate the setting of a briefing schedule, the Court directs counsel to confer and to file on the docket by 5:00 p.m. today a joint status report indicating whether they have agreed on a schedule for the filing of response and reply briefs, taking into account the Court's views as expressed above. If no agreement is reached, the Court will set a briefing schedule in a forthcoming order. Given that the CARES Act is fixed at this time (though always subject to amendment by Congress, of course) and that the proposed class is clearly defined in the complaint and opening brief, the Court's present impression is that a hearing will not be needed at least until after response and reply briefs are filed and reviewed by the Court.
