**ORDER**

On July 2, 2013, the court issued an Order finding this case to be moot. (ECF No. 1845.) The Order directed the parties and the Special Master to file final motions for fees and costs within twenty-eight days, and advised the parties that, after resolving these motions, the court would decertify the class and dismiss this case.

On July 29, 2013, the parties filed a joint stipulation and proposed Order regarding outstanding fees and costs. (ECF No. 1850.) The court has entered this Order. (ECF No. 1852.)

1           On November 18, 2013, the Special Master filed a declaration  
2 indicating that no further fees or expenses are owed to him in  
3 this matter. (ECF No. 1862.) The court thanks the Special Master  
4 for his service.

5           One matter remains. In response to plaintiffs' motion for  
6 reconsideration (ECF No. 1849), the court issued an Order, dated  
7 September 10, 2013, which provided in pertinent part:

8           Defendants are DIRECTED to maintain the  
9 injunctive relief previously ordered in this  
10 matter in place for those alleged parole  
11 violators who were arrested prior to July 1,  
12 2013, but whose alleged parole violations  
13 have not yet been addressed by defendants.  
14 Defendants are FURTHER DIRECTED to file a  
15 declaration no later than October 1, 2013  
16 apprising the court as to the status of these  
17 alleged parole violators' cases, and to  
18 continue doing so on the first of each month  
19 thereafter, until all of the outstanding  
20 cases have been disposed of. Thereafter, the  
21 court will resolve the outstanding motions  
22 for fees and costs, decertify the class, and  
23 dismiss this case. (ECF No. 1859).

24 Defendants subsequently filed a declaration averring that all  
25 parole revocation proceedings for alleged parole violators who  
26 were arrested before July 1, 2013 have been completed. (ECF  
27 No. 1861.)

28           In light of the foregoing, the court hereby orders as  
follows:

[1] The plaintiff class, certified by Order dated December  
1, 1994 (Dkt. No. 76), is DECERTIFIED.

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[2] The Stipulated Order for Permanent Injunctive Relief  
(ECF No. 1034) is TERMINATED.

[3] The Clerk of the Court is DIRECTED to close this case.  
IT IS SO ORDERED.
