The Court has been informed that the correctional facility that was the subject of this lawsuit -- the Central Facility -- was permanently closed in November 2001 as required by the National Capital Revitalization and Self Government Improvement Act, D.C. Code § 24-1201, et. seq., and that the inmates formerly housed at that facility, who constituted the plaintiff class, are now housed in other facilities under the supervision of the Federal Bureau of Prisons. Given the closure of this facility, and the alternative arrangements for the incarceration of the former plaintiff class, the plaintiff class certified in this action has ceased to exist. Accordingly, the parties have jointly moved to vacate all Orders entered herein except for those Orders regarding the duties of the Special Officer of the Court to assist and advise the Court regarding the expenditure of the contempt fine funds that have already been deposited with the Court pursuant to Orders entered in this civil action. Upon consideration of that request and the entire record herein, it is by the Court this 7th day of May, 2002
