ORDER STAYING CASE

On December 2, 2004, the Court entered an order in this case indicating that the outcome of this case will be affected by rulings in Goff, et al. v. Graves, et al., No. 4:97-cv-90341, a case that concerned the Church of the New Song, also known as CONS.

Iowa Department of Corrections officials have sought court relief with respect to CONS in Wycoff, et al. v. Brewer, et al., No. 4:05-cv-00068-RP-RAW. On February 18, 2005, the Court in Wycoff scheduled proceedings in that case, including an evidentiary hearing. Because the outcome of the proceedings in Wycoff very likely will impact the continued validity of Plaintiffs' claims in Voshell, the Court **stays** the proceedings in Voshell pending the outcome of Wycoff or upon a showing of good cause by the parties to resume proceedings.
