Based upon the Findings of Facts, Conclusions of Law, Memorandum Decision and Order entered on March 16, 1999, it is Ordered and Adjudged that Plaintiffs be awarded a Declaratory Judgment decreeing that Defendants have engaged in unlawful retaliation against members of the class of inmate Plaintiffs while such inmates were engaged in the pursuit of federally guaranteed rights, but prospective injunctive relief is denied because the retaliatory conduct occurring was not sufficiently pervasive to warrant relief.
