***MEMORANDUM ORDER***

SHADUR, District Judge.

\*1 Defendants have filed an extensive document, with exhibits, that they caption “Motion for Clarification or in the Alternative Reconsideration of the Remedial Order.” In material part, plaintiffs and counsel are correct when they state in their brief response that what is involved for the most part is the reargument of matters previously advanced by defendant, considered by this Court and rejected in the course of preparing the February 28, 1989 Remedial Order. In any event, defendants’ motion is denied. Fortunately it appears from the reports by Special Master Norval Morris that neither the filing nor the pendency of that motion has interfered with defendants’ efforts toward implementing the Remedial Order and making it work. It is to be hoped that those efforts will continue in the same spirit with which they have begun, rather than the tone reflected in the now-denied motion.
