

The parties hereto, through their undersigned counsel, hereby stipulate that under present populations and projections, and with a delay in the construction of the Lower Savannah Work Center housing facilities for females, the earliest date on which the Department of Corrections could cease to use the TV rooms for housing would be March, 1990, rather than February, 1990, as had been stated in the SCDC August 1, 1989, Report. While the TV rooms have remained occupied, the Department has not had to use the gym for housing since shortly after the Greenwood female facility opened in early September. Except as noted above, other female housing conditions are similar to those at the time of the September hearing.
