**ORDER**

On August 2, 2007, the Court convened a hearing to discuss any pending issues. There appeared on behalf of Plaintiff, Mr. Theodore Gordon and Mr. Jeff Aston; on behalf of Defendants, Mr. Frank J. Mellen, Jr. and Ms. Rosemary Miller, General Counsel for the School Board.

After discussing the status of the case on remand from the United States Supreme Court, the Court determined that based upon the School Board's current expressed intentions, it was in compliance with the Supreme Court's ruling. All present agreed and, therefore, no further ruling was required.<sup>1</sup> Plaintiff's counsel stated that he would not be seeking any further equitable relief on behalf of Plaintiff or any other persons. The Court noted that this resolution was consistent with the handling of relief arising from the Court's decisions in 2000 and 2004. Neither party raised additional issues. The other pending issues concerning Plaintiff's actual damages and attorney's fees were set for briefing.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the motion for attorney fees (DN #84) and the motion for damages (DN #80) are REMANDED and counsel for Plaintiff shall have thirty (30) days in which to resubmit the motions.
