A telephone status conference was conducted by the undersigned in the above-referenced matter on June 3, 2013, at 2:00 p.m. Participating were Ryan Wilson, counsel for United States Department of Justice (“DOJ”); Bob Hammonds and Pam Dill, counsel for Jackson Parish School Board (“School Board”); and Kayla Dye May, Law Clerk.

Ms. Dill reported that the parties are continuing to make progress on either reaching agreement on the *Green* factors or clarifying the issues that will remain for hearing. The DOJ has retained an expert, and he will be present for a site visit at the end of the month.

Because of a conflict, the Court continued the unitary status hearing from September 16, 2013, to October 1, 2013, at 9:00 a.m. The Court also extended the parties’ deadline to July 26, 2013, to file a consent decree on the *Green* factors and/or file a joint status report advising the Court which factor(s) will need to be addressed at hearing.
