



Secretary of State Jennifer Brunner and Intervenor-defendant the State of Ohio oppose the motion. After reviewing the briefs and considering the arguments of all parties, the Court **GRANTS** Plaintiffs' Revised Motion for Leave to File *Instantly* a Supplemental Complaint (no 120).

Also before the Court is the Ohio Democratic Party's ("ODP") Motion to Intervene (no. 148) filed on November 4, 2008. Based upon the oral arguments of counsel, the fact that Defendant does not oppose said Motion, and for the reasons set forth on the record, the Court finds ODP's motion well taken and hereby grants same. The Ohio Democratic Party's Motion to Intervene is **GRANTED**.
